

HONEYBEE DIARIES from Neil Wellum



Warm, sunny weather has arrived in earnest after a cooler than normal spring. Thank goodness. I have continued to split colonies as part of my swarm control endeavours, so it has been a busy time for me. I am hoping to bring on two new queens from the latest two splits I have carried out. You may remember that, last month, I helped a new queen emerge into one of the first colonies I split. She seems to be doing well and is in her third week of laying eggs after mating. I have marked her thorax with a blob of white paint to make her easier to spot when I inspect the hive and to keep track of her age. There is a simple colour code procedure beekeepers can follow so they know the year in which the queen was raised. Last year it was blue, this year white.

Mating is a risky business for a new queen and her colony. She mates on the wing and must do so in roughly the first four weeks of her life, or it is too late for her. She only flies a few times in her life, first when she is mating and then a year or so later, if and when the colony sends out a prime swarm. Drones (male bees) have the sole function of mating with the queen. They may fly seven or eight times per day out to drone congregation areas (DCAs), waiting for a virgin queen to come along. The DCAs are typically between 10 and 40m above ground. Drones will fly 500m or so from the hive to the DCA where they meet up loosely with drones from other hives. (The comparison with teenage boys comes to mind.) DCAs tend to be the same from one year to the next, but nobody knows quite why or how they are chosen. They are often in places with strong geographic features like the edges of fields, or the sides of a grassy hilltop.

When the queen is ready to mate, she first needs to orientate herself with her hive to make sure she knows precisely where it is so that she can get back safely. She will then pick some fine weather and will fly to a DCA at least 1500m away, so that she doesn't mate with the drones from her colony. She needs to avoid this since they share the same mother and that would cause genetic inbreeding.

If and when she flies through a DCA, the drones will pick up chemical pheromones she releases known as 'queen substance'. Drones are so sensitive to the smell, they can detect a virgin queen from a range of 100m and they will fly in towards the queen forming a comet tail of eager suitors. Drones have the largest eyes of all honeybees and finally use their very good eyesight to couple with the queen. The act of mating is a dramatic and swift affair and the drone will drop to the ground in the process, physically paralysed by the exertion involved, there to die.

The queen will mate with a number of drones, perhaps 10 to 20, over the course of a few mating flights, so the majority of drones do not get to fulfil their primary purpose. The queen has a special organ which stores their sperm, keeping them alive and nourished for the rest of her egg-producing life, which can be two to three years.

So, my new white queen managed to mate during a weather period which was far from ideal and get back to her hive safely. Well done her.

I never cease to be amazed by the honeybee.
